Jodi's mother was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2007 and underwent two mastectomy surgeries. Cancer is prevalent in her family with three of her mother's sisters, Monica, Edna and Catherine, also having had breast cancer in recent years and her sister Theresa having passed away from bone marrow cancer shortly before Christmas 2005. Her father's side of the family has been touched by breast cancer as well; her aunt Veronica had a mastectomy about 30 years ago, as did her father's mother Mary and her only sister Elsie.

The Weekend to End Women's Cancers is a two-day, 60-kilometre walk through the neighbourhoods of Vancouver taking place on **August 13th & 14th**. Proceeds benefit the **BC Cancer Foundation**, funding important breast cancer research, education, services and care. In order to participate in the weekend, **walkers must raise \$2,000.00** benefiting the BC Cancer Foundation.

Since 2004 **The Weekend to End Women's Cancers** has raised over **\$16 million** enabling numerous advances in cancer research and care.
